Due to so many issues, it has become necessary to end financial support of the home at the close of this year. I can't tell you how much this pains us, but we trust the Lord's direction and plan at a time when we lack full understanding.

We cannot thank you enough for your years of support, whether financially or through prayer. We so appreciate those of you who have let us know that you will turn to other opportunities outside of POGO. And, thank you to those of you who have let us know that you will continue your support with Cladel's church and ministry.

Where God has closed one door, he has opened wide another.

Going forward, our efforts will focus on Cladel's ministry through his church and Jeremiah Ministries. Funding has allowed him to help several children attend various schools in the community surrounding his church. The goat ministry is taking off with the first 2 babies being born. The Saturday children's program, Klèb Jibile, is drawing a crowd. Families in the community have received assistance with medical concerns, food, shelter, and other needs.

Cladel's ministry gives me hope. Hope for Haiti. Hope for us.

Home Rebuild – Mackenson is the worship leader at Cladel's church. He and his family of six live in this small 2 room shack. Funds were received to build a wall to protect the property and to begin blocking in his home. Cladel estimates that \$2000 will cover the remaining needs – block to finish the walls, tin for the roof, a door, and stucco. Due to security concerns, we will only share of this need via email.

Church Property – We are so grateful enough funds have been received to purchase the church property! We are hopeful the purchase process will be completed by the time Jubilee Christian Church International Haiti celebrates their 3 year anniversary. Phase 2 of the building project will include building a wall around the property. This is an important and necessary step for securing properties in Haiti. Future plans include building a well, church, and school.
